EVkids is a Boston nonprofit that works with inner-city youth from 4th grade through high school to help them succeed in school and in life. Children and teens from Dorchester and Roxbury are matched with university students for one-on-one, multi-year tutoring and mentoring that prepares them for college. Family engagement, school advocacy, and a summer camp in Vermont add to ongoing mentoring relationships to create a strong community of support. **Since 2007, 100% of our high school seniors have gone on to college.**
